## Describe How the Program Supports Family Connections

Families are invited to attend admissions and be a part of the treatment team when deemed appropriate by social worker. The agency employs a parent advocate that assist parents who are moving through the system. Family therapy and home visits are a part of treatment plan on a case by case basis. Transportation for home visits is made available when possible. When possible and therapeutically indicated, siblings are placed together and/or given family therapy.

## Special Interventions Available Internally

Case management is available to all children. There is 24-hour clinical on call coverage. Psychologicals and chemical dependency assessments are available through referrals to the Adanta out patient clinic. Chemical dependency treatment including individual therapy, IOP and after care groups are also available through Adanta outpatient clinic. School therapist, who are contracted through the school system, are available to children with targeted school behaviors.
