Key Assets provides extensive training to its foster carers and they are encouraged to attend monthly support group meetings arranged by the agency. Key Assets also provides specialized parent and child services that are designed to meet the unique needs of an under aged parent and his or her child/children.

Describe How the Program Supports Family Connections

Key Assets involves the birth families in the treatment of the children/youth in our care to the fullest extent possible. Specifically, whenever deemed appropriate by the child welfare agency we invite birth families to be active participants in the treatment planning process through Team Parenting Meetings. Key Assets staff and foster carers also provide transportation to visits and staff supervise visitation as needed.

Special Interventions Available Internally

Key Assets offers therapeutic and support services that are based on the Team Parenting Model that places an emphasis on trauma informed care. Key Assets offers individual, family, and group therapy and support services within the Team Parenting Framework that include the services of therapeutic child support workers and educational liaisons. Other interventions include: case management, 24 hour/365 day a year crisis support, strength-based documentation and direct care staff and foster carers certified in SCM-Verbal Intervention Techniques.

Description of how the program exceeds licensure ratios

Key Assets case managers hold a maximum of 8 cases when the child or youth in care require therapeutic foster care services.
