Our services include Weekly Intensive Case Management, Comprehensive Treatment planning, 24 hour on call crisis support, Individual and group therapy, Pre-Independent Living Programming, Detailed Monthly Reports to Referring Agencies and 24-hour response on all referrals. We provide continuous training opportunities for our parents on topics such as Behavior Management; De-escalation, Policy/Procedure, Cultural Diversity, Independent Living and needs identified by the individual youth's assessment. We have well trained staff with advanced degrees in social work, human services, psychology and education. We strive to take the best possible care of the people we serve and those who serve them. Our approach to supporting youth and families is grounded in the twelve principles of Re-education and five premises set forth by Nicholas Hobbs.
