Our staff members hold advanced degrees in social work, psychology, and counseling. Necco-Louisville ensures each child is provided a stable, supportive, and loving environment. Our services include intensive case management, 24-hour crisis support, mental health evaluations for all children, individual, group and family therapy (as appropriate), and ongoing support and training for our foster parents. We currently provide treatment foster care placements for children from birth to 21-years-old. This office has elected not to utilize Safe Crisis Management (SCM) restraint techniques.

Describe How the Program Supports Family Connections

Staff members and foster families are provided continuous training about partnering with biological family members to realize the goal of reunification. Necco provides transportation to biological family visits and monitors the frequency and appropriateness of approved family contacts. In addition, biological family members are encouraged to participate in their child's Comprehensive Treatment Planning. Family therapy is offered to promote healthy attachment and ease the child's transition back into the home.

Special Interventions Available Internally

In addition to weekly case management services, treatment planning and 24-hour crisis support, Necco-Louisville provides the following therapeutic services to the children we serve: Cognitive Therapy, Cognitive Behavioral Therapy, Narrative Therapy, Art and Play Therapy, Brief Therapy, Solutions-Focused Therapy, Psychoeducational Support Groups and Family Therapy.
